

## How to worship remotely with Hackberry Creek Church

### 1. **Facebook Live**      **Every Sunday morning 9:30 am**

Pastor Jonathan Tony and our praise team, Calling Canaan, will lead us in worship each Sunday via Facebook Live until the church building is open for worship again. The Order of Worship (with song lyrics) will be made available via email and will be posted on [www.hackberrycreekchurch.com](http://www.hackberrycreekchurch.com) and on Hackberry Creek Church Facebook's profile.

#### **How to access us Facebook Live:**

1-If you don't have a Facebook Account, go to [www.facebook.com](http://www.facebook.com) and you'll see a place to Create a New Account. Do so by following the instructions there.

2-Log in to Facebook and in the Search field, type "Hackberry Creek Church" (not the quotes) and hit Enter.

3-In the top box, you should see a tiny video screen showing our church. Click on it to make it large, then move your cursor across the picture and you'll see a speaker icon at the bottom. If there's an X on it, click the icon and remove the X, which gives you sound. To the right of that icon, click on the arrows pointing outward, to make the picture fill your screen.

4-You're ready to watch and listen
